

An extended kiddish is a one-hour (11:15 a.m.- 12:15 p.m.) gathering with sweet trays, light food, and fruit after the B'nei Mitzvah morning service for up to 85 people. An extended kiddush must be reserved at least 4 months in advance of the service.

The cost of an Extended Kiddish is \$475, which includes:

- room rental
- staff to set up and clean up, 9:00am-1:00pm
- required security
- Kiddish for one hour. **There is no option to extend this time.**

Additional important information:

- Beth Am will provide challah and juice for you and your guests
- Any Kiddush food must be brought in pre-plated (i.e., on trays)
- The family provides all napkins, cups, utensils, small plates, bags, foil for leftovers etc.
- All food, drink, and supplies can be brought to Beth Am between 9:15am and 9:30am on the Saturday of the Bnei Mitzvah service. If the family would like to bring the extended Kiddush food and supplies the day before the service, our Friday hours are normally 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- We do not have refrigerator space for deli trays. Trays must be delivered to Beth Am on the day of the service between 10:30am-10:45am
- Please make arrangements with Carol Yesnick at the synagogue at least two weeks in advance of your service if you would like to drop off supplies and food on the Friday before your service. Unfortunately, due to space, we cannot guarantee the refrigeration of most items.
- If you would like coffee service, you can bring in coffee, or Beth Am will provide Coffee and tea service for your guests at a cost of \$30 for up to 20 people, \$60 for up to 40 people, \$95 for up to 60 people, and \$128 for up to 85 people.
