We are planning for an exciting and enriching year and to do this efficiently, we need your help. **Please complete your online registration and tuition deposit by going to your “My Beth Am” portal.**

1. There, you will find the online registration and tuition deposit button labeled “26-27 Religious School Enrollment.”
2. The form does not save automatically, nor submit, until you complete all the fields and hit the submit button at the bottom. So please know that your draft won't save.

Your registration will help us plan for special events and hire staff. Please help us prepare with your timely registration.

Again, school registration forms should be completed electronically by **going to www.bethambq.org, logging into your “My Beth Am” portal, and pressing the “26-27 Religious School Enrollment” button.** There you will find all the registration materials required to register your child(ren) for the upcoming school year, including:

- a. Confidential Student Information: If there is any information that you can provide which will help determine the proper class placement for your child(ren), please include that information on this form. Information about learning challenges is of particular importance. The information you provide will be kept confidential. It will be shared, if necessary, only with a child's teacher(s).
- b. Emergency Contact Form
- c. Dual Schooling Policy Form
- d. Photography Release & Student Internet Access
- e. Tuition: Please see the School Registration Information Page for the 2026 – 2027 School Tuition Fees.
- f. Early Bird Discount: Help us plan for next year and save money at the same time. If you register and pay the tuition deposit by June 8th, 2026, you will save \$50 per Gan – 7th grade child.

We are committed to providing your child(ren) with a high-quality Jewish education. We are committed to bringing your entire family a sense of closeness to the Jewish people, and a connection to our own blossoming congregational community.
